JCW Floor Screeding - Shopfitting

Sticks and Sushi, Canary Wharf

Sticks'n'Sushi was founded 20 years ago by the brothers Kim & Jens Rahbek together with Thor Andersen. Taking inspiration from their half-Japanese, half-Danish background, they created a unique cuisine that combined two culinary traditions – Sushi and Yakitori from the charcoal grills.

Located in the waters of the north dock next to the HSBC tower, the restaurant is situated in the new Crossrail building designed by Norman Foster. The space consists of one big, generous room, which is underlined by a 23 meter long bar including an open kitchen, a take away service as well as the beverage function.
